Conference Registration and Fees

The CPMA and the ISCC are pleased to offer this two-day conference at a low registration fee of only **(US)\$625**. Registrants who wish to attend both the Color Pigments Conference and the ISCC Annual Meeting are being offered a combined rate of **(US)\$725**. (For CPMA and ISCC members the conference fee is **(US)\$525** and the combined fee for both the conference and the ISCC Annual meeting is **(US)\$625**.) Included are all educational sessions, two evening receptions, two continental breakfasts, coffee breaks, the All-Conference Luncheon, and copies of conference presentations. The Pre-Conference Golf Tournament is additional (see below). **NOTE THAT THE REGISTRATION DEADLINE AND THE HOTEL RESERVATION DEADLINE ARE BOTH MARCH 31, 2000.**

For those registrants bringing a **guest or spouse**, individual tickets to food & beverage functions are available. Each continental breakfast is **(US)\$15 per person**, the welcoming reception on Monday is **(US)\$30 per person**, the Tuesday evening reception is **(US)\$40 per person**, and the All-Conference Luncheon is **(US)\$75 per person**. Pre-Conference Golf Tournament
